Pasta Potluck

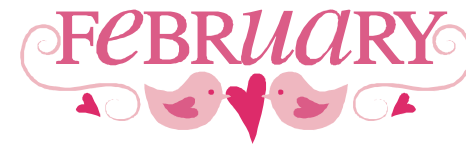
Next Sunday following worship!
