A Sign of Spring

In The Story of the Easter Robin, Dandi Daley MacKall retells an old Pennsylvania Dutch tale of the robin's compassion as he witnessed Jesus' death. On Good Friday, a plain brown bird flying over Jerusalem was curious about the "nest"



atop Jesus' head. When the bird realized it was a crown of thorns, he tried to dislodge it. As the robin pulled out a long thorn from Jesus' forehead, a drop of blood landed on the bird's breast, staining it red. Now the robin's red breast is a symbol of Jesus' loving sacrifice, and the robin's early spring song is a reminder of Jesus' joyful resurrection.
