Maundy Thursday Service April 2, 2015 7:00

The day before Good Friday is called *Maundy Thursday*. The word "*Maundy*" comes from the Latin word <u>manadatum</u> which means "commandment." In the gospel of John, Jesus makes this statement during the Last Supper: "I am with you only a little longer... I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." (John 13:33-35, NRSV).

Maundy Thursday should always be a time of sharing with others, showing loving concern for one another, and partaking of the Holy Communion. That is what the Lord asked of his disciples and asks of us.

Notes on Today's Insert, "Our Lord, You Stood in Pilate's Hall"

To ordinary people looking on, Jesus must have seemed insignificant as he stood before Pilate as through the eyes of faith we see Christ "at the right hand of God" ruling over all creation. Though we know this, there are plenty of times when we ask, "When will your reign be known?" Another way of asking this might be an elderly relative; a father waits in at the hospital for news of his son who has been shot; children and families involved in violence. "When will your reign be known?" At the same time, Christians in comfortable churches, with comfortable lives, pray, "Thy kingdom come, thy will be done..." We pray not to get so caught up in the comfortable ways of our culture that we lose sight of something more precious. We pray that we may seek God's kingdom first, and most of all.
