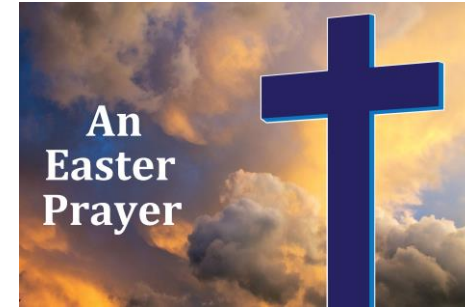
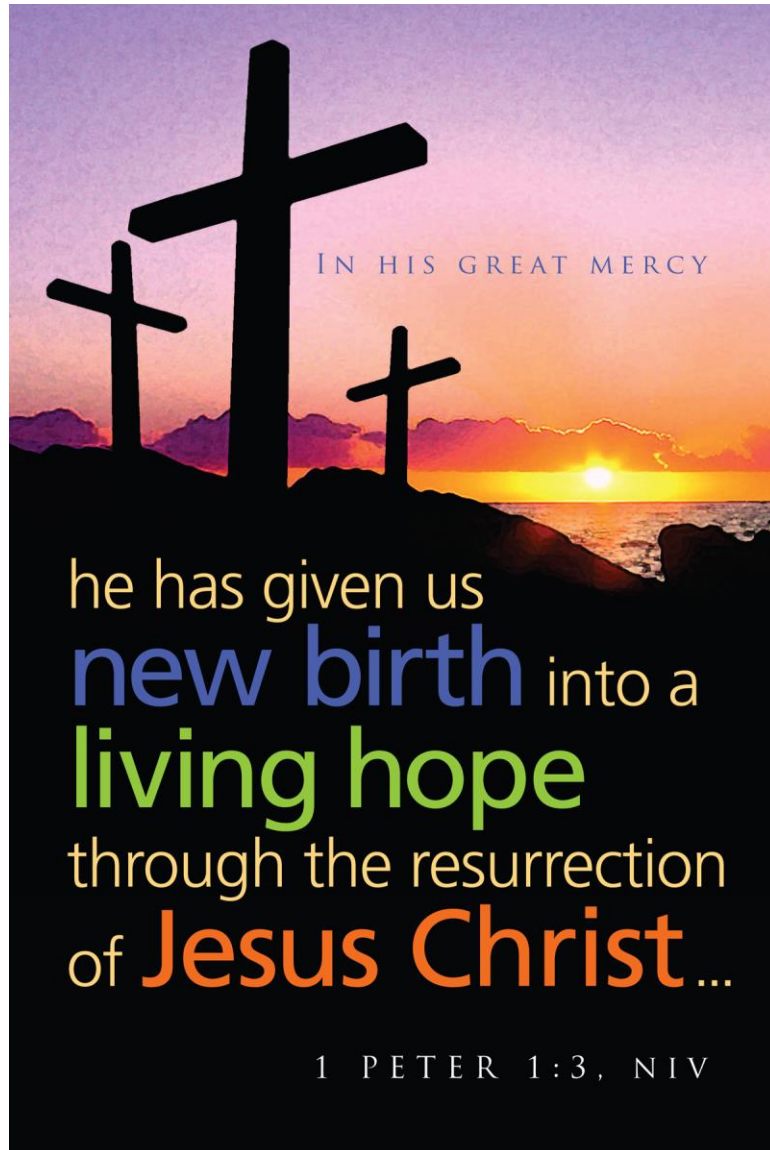

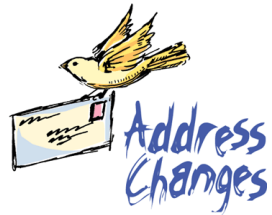


We reach out in thought and prayer for those who are hurting, who are facing surgeries and/or treatments, for those with unspoken struggles known only within the realms of their own hearts...
