



Do you know about the work of the ministry teams?

Ministry teams cover the basic areas of church life. Beginning today, and for the next three Sundays, ministry team representatives will give a brief summary of how they spend their budget dollars and how it serves the church family. This week's focus is on the Stewardship Ministry Team. Their responsibilities are highlighted below.



The specific responsibilities of the Stewardship Ministry Team are:

- Plan and carry out a program of stewardship education.
- Encourage the church family to give regularly.
- Guide the leadership team with annual budget preparations.
- Direct and plan the annual budget process.
- Arrange for receiving and disbursing monies of the church as authorized by the congregation and/or leadership team.
- Interpret and communicate the financial status of the church through written monthly reports.
- Provide offering envelopes to the congregation.
- Select person(s) to count and verify in writing to the treasurer all offerings.
- Select persons to deposit weekly offerings to the bank.
- Arrange for an annual audit of the church financial records.
- Inform the congregation of stewardship opportunities and needs outside the church.
- Study and recommend benevolent monies to various ministries.
