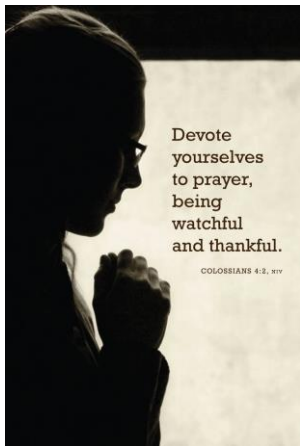
Hayrides and Train Rides
