### Stewardship Report

Contributions for the month of **September** totaled \$10,465 and expenses were \$14,861 resulting in a negative balance of \$4,396. On a year-to-date basis, contributions totaled \$101,896 and expenses totaled \$107,376 for a **negative balance of \$5,480.**

Since we operate on a cash basis and some commitments are paid quarterly, about \$1,200 would be our monthly part of that commitment. We are working with a **CHALLENGE** budget and appreciate your support and commitment making it possible for Lincolnshire to continue doing God's work. Thank you!

### Parsonage Report

The parsonage committee met on Sunday, October 2. In attendance were Herb Trip, Jerry Wood, Stan Gorom, Howard Pletcher and Marv Loutsenhizer.

1. Marv reported a positive fund balance on August 30, of \$2,434.
2. The amount of rent was reviewed and it was decided that there would be no increase at this time for the following reasons. The renters have always paid on time, there is no damage to the property and Jerry Wood explained that the \$700 was in line with the market for that type of property and its location
3. Of the \$700 monthly rent, \$235 is paid to the Bibbees for housing allowance, and \$250 to the churches' general fund. The group voted to keep the payments the same at this time due to the age of the property, the roof, furnace, and other potential repairs.
4. A ground hog has been burrowing along the foundation. Howard said that he captured the ground hog and it is no longer a problem. He refilled the large hole and he doesn't expect another intruder. If there is, it also will have to deal with Howard.
5. Current repairs: Fred Ilnicki replaced the exhaust fan in the main bathroom on October 1, and Jerry Wood will paint the ceiling with mold sealant paint on October 4.
6. Stan reported that the shrubs planted this summer died due to hot temperatures and lack of rain. The committee will re-plant.
7. Marv expressed thanks to the committee plus Casey, Fred, and others for their help with repairs which makes the parsonage rental a good experience. The efforts of all save the church significant expenses.
