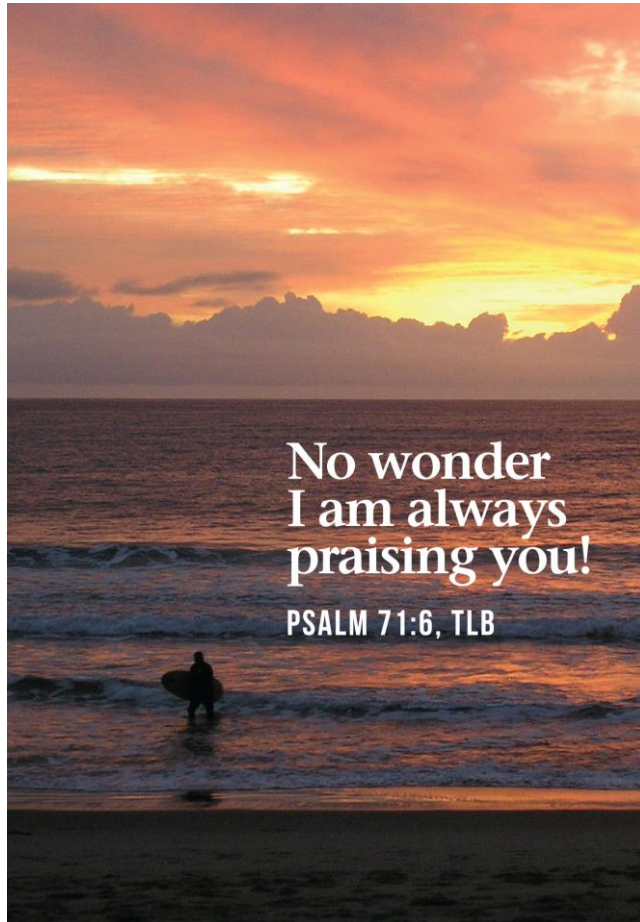

standard ovens. The need for a replacement was noted while cooking for a combined free dinner with the church down the street. Some of the burners would not stay lit and the oven door on one was held in place with a bungee cord! **Lori Linn**, encouraged by **Jan Ward** and **Paula Sosenheimer**, took to the internet and found this stove in a school in Avilla. Jan and Paula checked it out and agreed that this was just what we needed, especially since the price was **\$700!** (If new, the cost is \$5,700). With Leadership Team's approval, they forged ahead and made the necessary arrangements to get it to Lincolnshire. Aha, you ask...how many dinners do we need to sell in order to pay for it? Not a problem... with Stewardship's approval, Jan used the memorial monies from her parents (John and Marcile Welborn) and the remainder was taken from Gerry Westerfield's son's memorial. The stove was installed by Korte and that expense was paid by Lori Linn. As most women know, if you get something new, everything around it must be cleaned, scrubbed, rearranged and polished up. So the women, in a frenzy of cleaning, did just that. We now have a kitchen that is **functional** and **clean!** No price tag can be put on the cooperative effort and work that these women did. It serves as a sterling example of spirited group volunteerism at its finest!
