

#### Congregational Meeting of November 12, 2017

The meeting was opened with prayer by Marv Loutsenhizer after which minutes of November 13, 2016 and April 30, 2017 congregational meetings were approved.

**Trustees of the Corporation:** A motion was made by Stan Gorom and seconded by Bill Leverton to appoint the following persons as Trustees of the Corporation:

Church Clerk—Carolyn Egolf

Treasurer—Marilyn Drudge Motion passed.

**Annual Conference Delegates:** Evelyn Bickel moved and Ruth Strole seconded the affirmation of Dave Bell as Annual Conference delegate for 2018 and Marilyn Drudge as the 2018 alternate. Motion passed.

**Reports:** Ministry Team Reports as well as Pastors' Report were accepted. Pastor Paul Thomas noted that he & Cheryl report monthly to Leadership Team on their activities. Appreciation was expressed for all who participate in the life of the congregation and the ministries that makes it possible.

**Treasurer's Report :** Marilyn Drudge noted that the current budget is \$119,391, and giving continues to exceed expenses.

**Foundation Work:** A video, prepared by Lori Linn using photos taken by Stan Gorom, of the work done on the northeast corner of the church in September was shown. Cost of the project was \$11,400, and repairs done now are intended to prevent problems later. Thanks to Stan, Marv, Howard, Jack and others who monitored the project.

**Budget**-Bob Kaylor: The 2018 proposed budget is \$121,503 with pledges of \$120,970. Line items related to pastoral expenses are estimated, but budget should be adequate to cover those costs. A motion by Joe Henderson to adopt the budget was seconded by Ruth Strole. Motion passed.

#### Stewardship Items:

- Social Action Emergency Policy, revised May 27, 2017, provides guidance for amounts and procedures to assist members and regularly attending friends of the congregation. Bob Kaylor moved and Stan Gorom seconded adoption of the policy. Motion passed.
- 2. **Policy regarding large item/project approval process:** This policy, dated February 16, 2016, offers guidelines for procedures related to purchases, leases, or rentals over \$750. Bob Kaylor moved, and Joe Henderson seconded approval of policy. Motion passed.
