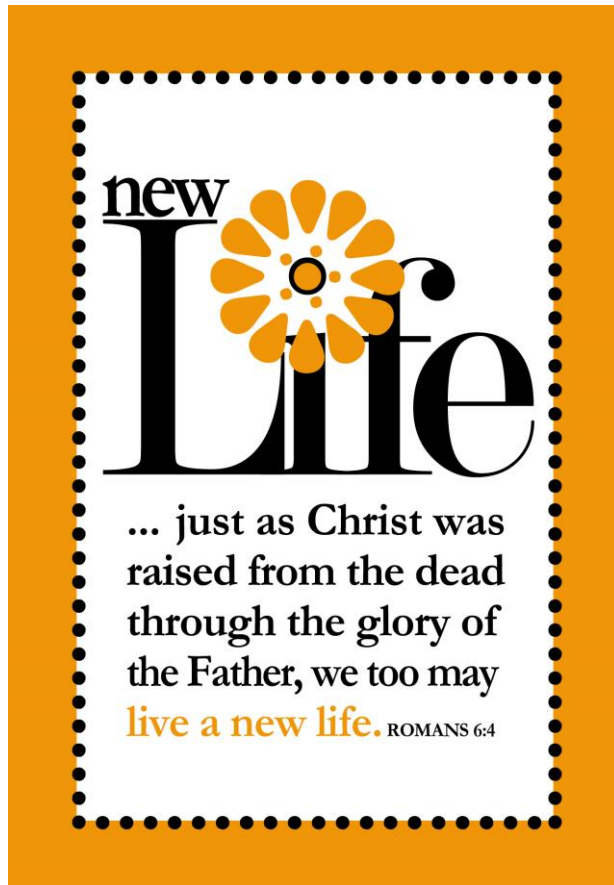

Notes by Carolyn Egolf

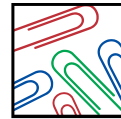
