
Excerpts from the Feb. 18, 2018 sermon

Last Sunday, we touched on three of the five purposes for belonging to a church.

- The first purpose is evangelism, which is communicating God's Word. It is every Christian's responsibility to be a messenger of God's love and tell the Good News wherever we go.
- The second purpose of the church is worship. We find the
 definition of worship in Luke 10:27a, which states, "Love the Lord
 your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all
 your strength and with all your mind..."

The third purpose of the church is publicly stating that you belong to the body of believers through baptism which leads to continual fellowship. Baptism and fellowship identifies us with the body of Christ. As Christians we are called to belong, not just to believe. This week, we will look at the last two purposes of the church. ~ Pastor Paul


