

## **Highlighting two Sunday School Classes**

Heather Grady's class will be studying the book written by Rachel Held Evans, "Inspired: Slaying Giants, Walking on Water and Loving the Bible



Again." An Amazon review reads: If the Bible isn't a science book or an instruction manual, then what is it? What do people mean when they say the Bible is *inspired*? When Rachel Held Evans found herself asking these questions, she began a quest to better understand what the Bible is and how it is meant to be read. Drawing on the best in recent scholarship and using her well-honed literary expertise, Evans examines some of our favorite Bible stories and possible interpretations, retelling them through memoir, original

poetry, short stories, soliloquies, and even a short screenplay. Undaunted by the Bible's most difficult passages, Evans wrestles through the process of doubting, imagining, and debating Scripture's mysteries. Evans specializes in tantalizing book titles including one bearing the title of "A Year of Biblical Womanhood: How a Liberated Woman Found Herself Sitting on Her Roof and Calling Her Husband "Master." Heather's class meets downstairs in the church parlor.

The Altruist Class will study "The Ten Commandments from the Backside" by J. Elsworth Kalas. These questions are posed for class discussion: "Are the commandments relevant for today? Each commandment is discussed in depth as we attempt to make sense of centuries-old Biblical text. Join the class that meets in the room across from the library on the first floor.
