

After Jan Williams explained procedural changes regarding agendas, both distribution and order of reports, Laura gave devotions and prayer. Amended minutes from Aug. 22 meeting were approved. Correction reads: "Contracts have been let for attic project. One is for closing the holes where bats enter by Bats Be Gone. The other contract is for removing damaged and adding new insulation by Momper Insulation. The final total cost is \$3,518, down from a prior quote of \$7,452."

Treasurer's Report—Mary Loutsenhizer:


- 1. Checking account and General Fund balances "look good."

Contributions for the month of Aug totaled \$9,360 and expenses were \$10,583 resulting in a **negative balance of \$1,223**. On a year-to-date basis, contributions totaled \$94,937 and expenses totaled \$97,699 for a negative balance of \$2,762. Since we operate on a cash basis and some commitments are paid quarterly, about \$1,500 would be our monthly part of that commitment. Our budget expects \$10,125 each month. Thank you for continuing to keep your pledge giving on track. We appreciate your support and commitment making it possible for Lincolnshire to continue doing God's work.
