Concerns over canned foods with expired dates was a subject of discussion at the last board meeting. It was voiced that we should not be giving out food with old dates. In checking with other churches in the Fort Wayne area who have food pantries, it was

discovered that their policy for handling foods with expired dates is that rather than discard them, the products are placed in an area with a sign indicating that altho they are beyond their expiration dates, they can still be taken as part of their food bags. One church has a very large food pantry that includes fresh produce, bread, etc. and is inspected by the Board of Health on an ongoing basis. They report that they do not have any problems with that approach. Effective immediately, such cans will be placed alongside the gray collection bin by the elevator with the appropriate sign on display. Jack Steckly has been faithful in checking expiration dates on foods and we feel this is a doable approach to providing food to the neighborhood. We appreciate all your donations to our food pantry that enhance the meals of many in our neighborhood.
