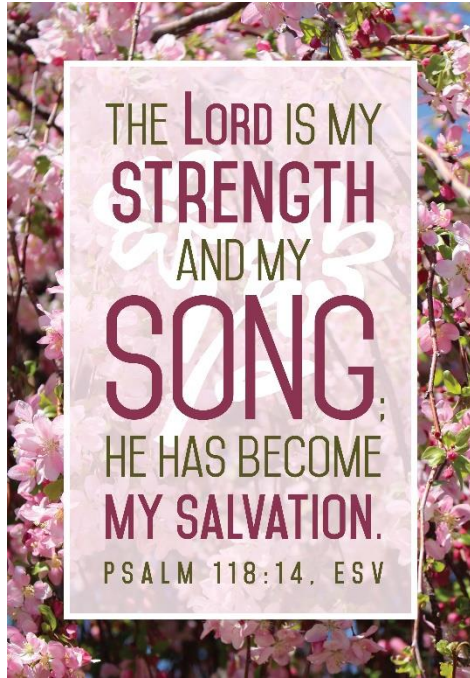

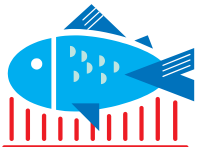
Are you willing to share what God has done for you?
