An informational meeting will be held next Sunday following the worship service. Copies of the preliminary budget will be distributed with explanations of line items. This is an excellent time to ask questions you may have regarding expenditures, the process of preparing the budget and the distribution of church funds or any other questions germane to church dollars. You are urged to attend.

Stewardship Committee reports that contributions for the month of August totaled \$10,797 with expenses of \$10,336 resulting in a positive balance of \$461. Year to date contributions total \$85,577 and expenses total \$87,116 for a **negative balance of \$1,539**. Even though we are spending more than we receive right now, we are ok financially. Bob Kaylor says "Remember that we cannot spend more than receive forever."
